Naming your child's belongings

Uniform- school sweatshirt, white polo-shirt, grey jogging trousers or grey trousers, black shoes- see school office if you need to order items.

Change of clothes- in a named bag to be hung on peg

Jewellery- studs

Behaviour- Golden, happy, worried, faces (time out)

Attendance & Punctuality



97% attendance is our whole school target!!

- **8:45am drop off and collect at 11:45pm (Morning session)**
- **12:15 drop off and collect at 3:15pm (Afternoon session)**
- **It is very important your child attends school every day as they miss out on learning!**

Sickness

- If your child is sick please phone the school office to let them know.
- If your child has sickness and diarrhoea and is feeling better after a day please send them into school. If it persists bring them back after 48hrs.
- **NO HOLIDAY LEAVE- If your child is taken out of school you may risk losing their place in school.**
- **Head lice- check your child's hair weekly. Please inform class teacher if you notice your child has it so all parents can be aware and check their child's hair.**

EYFS Assessment

- The 7 areas of learning and development guide the staff to plan for individual needs of your child as they learn new skills and knowledge
- Your child's learning and progress will be shared with you each term in parent's meetings.
- At the end of Nursery all children should be working within 40-60 mths development band in all areas of learning. They will be expected to have mastered skills such as counting, recognising numbers to 10, say what is 1 less/1 more, retelling simple stories, writing their name etc

9:20-10:30- Self chosen activities & adult led group activities

10:45-11:30- Self chosen activities & adult led group activities.

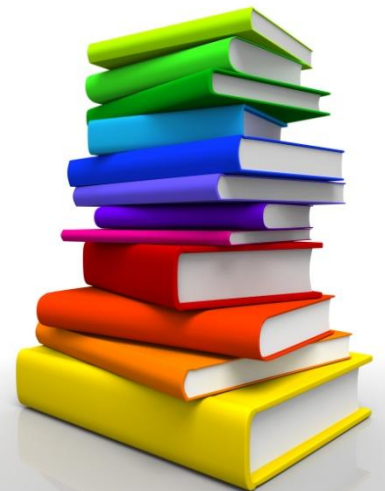
11:30-11:45 Story time & singing
