# Attendance and Punctuality

- It is important that your child attends school every day and they arrive promptly.
- The schools expectation is to reach 97% this year.
- Children with 90% attendance or below will be classed as having persistent absences.



# Changes to the curriculum in maths.



- Counting and writing numerals to 100
- Write numbers in words up to twenty
- Number bonds to 20, securely.
- Use of vocabulary such as equal, more than, less than, fewer etc.
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20.

# Changes to the curriculum in English



- Using full stops, capital letters and finger spaces in sentences
- Use capital letters for proper nouns
- Use 'and' and 'because' to join sentences
- Use a question mark to show where there is a question
- Use an exclamation mark to show an exclamation.

# Priorities in English

To understand the features of different genres:

- ◎ Instructional writing
- ◎ poetry
- ◎ Report writing (non chronological)
- ◎ Traditional tales
- ◎ Recounts
- ◎ Narrative (story writing)



# Grammar



- Grammatical terms e.g.
  - nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, conjunctions, past/present tense.
- Function of sentences:
  - Statements, questions, commands, exclamations.

# Punctuation



Children working at the expected standard are able to:

- Use full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.
- Use a capital letter to start a sentence, for names and personal pronoun 'I'
- Spelling (word list) - Parents to have on chair.



# Phonics Screening Check

- This will be administered in June 2017
- It will include 20 real words and 20 nonsense words.
- 93% of children passed the phonics screening check in June 2016.
- Children who do not pass will retake this in year 2.
- With support from home we hope to exceed this percentage.
- Sound cards are available to purchase from the office.





# Assessment



## How will your child be assessed?

- Continue to assess half termly.
- Levels will no longer be used
- Instead pupils will be assessed against year group expectations that are set out in the new national curriculum.
- Pupils will be assessed as beginning to achieve the year group expectations, working within the year group expectations or secure against the year group expectations.

## What will we report:

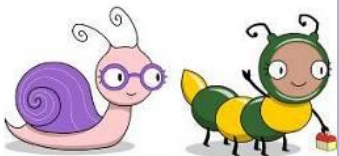
- Children's progress relating to the new steps,
